
Q6: What do you think should be the two main responsibilities of farmers in our society?

- 7 out of 10 Danish farms are loss-making (SEGES, october 2015)
- Danish agriculture debt: Ca 400.000.000.000 Danish kroner
- Eu just launched a multi million Euro support package for farmers to reduce production
- Meanwhile Demand for sustainable products are record high and continue to increase despite of loong financial crisis
- F.ex: Sale of organic products increasing year by year, in Denmark sale has tripled since 2006 (today 9% of retail sales)
- And: new key figures based on Danish Conservation farmers are very positive




